2.1 Body Science Presentation Proposal

- ❖ recap from previous meeting
 - Latashya shared a proposal with us from Kristine Hui (2nd year) regarding an innovative pharmaceutically themed educational program that she is involved in this summer
 - Kristine came to the meeting today to give us more information and answer any questions we had
- ❖ Discussion
 - Kristina will be working in collaboration with Science World to develop a program for school age children that is pharmaceutically based
 - the program will be called Body Science and the theme of the program will be pharmacy (she had wanted a more pharmacy related name but they felt that the children would not resonate with that)

- there is already a program running called 'Super Science Club' which is a nine week program catering to elementary school children(12 elementary school, 2 community centers, 905 children/year)
- they would like to rotate this program with their existing programs and themes with the idea of rotating the themes every four years
- a large portion of this program they hope to have funded by the grant they have applied for (they should know if they have received this funding by mid-April)
- Science World will also be supplying a portion of the funding
- they are not actually in need of volunteers, but they would welcome any interested students
- CAPSI has a Community Coordinator that goes into schools and give talks on pharmacy related topics
- perhaps we could connect these two groups to collaborate on ideas
