Discussions:

- 1. PhUS Budget: September Finances Review and Clubs Night Reimbursement Brad
- Team reimbursement: reach out to PhUS, get a reimbursement form, once approved PhUS pays for 50% of cost (except of ice hockey due to high cost usually \$400/team)
- Clubs Night expenses were placed under Clubs Fund
- Year events \$600/year
 - Large events suggest ticketing events
- If want to add new events to budget, should talk to Brad
- Add Clubs Fund and Professional Development Fund forms to the website

2. AMS Tutoring - Mitch

- Would cost \$1400 for first term, \$1600 for second term to pay for tutors
 - o Finance wise: would be feasible with current PhUS budget
 - Tutors would be recruited from within the faculty, would have regular workshops to maintain up-to-date academic material

- Would require building space for 2 sessions two times a week
 - Time would generally be in the evenings (5-7pm) however would be after hours and may require additional costs for additional security
 - o If during school time, fewer students can benefit from services but may be cheaper
- Start with academic tutoring, get feedback about student needs and then adapt as needed
 - Can initiate a pilot project in second term to look at opportunities for this program, tutor recruitment, logistics, finances, and student responses
- AMS willing to train and hire tutors already training tutors for all other faculties, have system with use of iPads regarding who comes in, common student questions, if tutoring is useful
- Require more student input in initiating a program
- Can place this program under VP Academic portfolio

Be it resolved that PhUS council transfers \$800 from the Clubs Fund to pay for the expenses of Pharmacy Clubs Night.
