- 1. Rho Chi Funding Applications
 - Refer to documents titled "PP-Club-Fund-Application.docx" and "ClubsFundApplication-Karen-Ng-Rho-Chi-15.10.16-pdf"
 - Fundraiser for Rho Chi so they can be financially independent
 - o Pharmily Pheud event on November 9th (Tentative)
 - Money will go toward other initiatives such as community presentation and Pi Week
 - Applying for the full amount of \$250 because there we can only apply once in an academic school year
 - Requesting that the unused amount would be carried forward for next year's event

- The application is for one event only so we should not allow the money to be carried over
- Council will approve reimbursement up to a maximum of \$250 and any unused amount will not be carried forward
- 2. PhUS Kappa Fundraiser Alex
 - Refer to document titled "No Shave November"
 - Fundraising competition to see who can grow out the best beard and to raise awareness
 - Might need a small fund aside from the sponsorship obtained
 - There will be 2-3 people from Kappa Psi helping
 - Need 2-3 people from council to help out in each year:
 - o First year: Kush
 - Second year: Margaret
 - o Third year: Melina
 - Volunteers will be making the games and class announcements
- 3. Peer Mentorship Program Funds Alex
 - Refer to document titled "Peer Mentorship Funding Proposal"
 - Ongoing sponsorship from PhUS
 - Requesting for more money (from \$500 to \$1000) to host more events for PMP
 - Host 1 major and 1 minor event per month, excluding December and April
 - Events to come until end of November: Karaoke and Board Games, Meet your Profs Night, Christmas Raffle Night
 - More events will help foster the relationship between the mentor and mentee
 - Most of the budget goes towards food and door prizes to give incentive for participation
 - Will be having 6-8 events per term
 - Currently, PMP still has \$500 from PhUS because of 2016 Winter Term 2 funding approval
- 4. Interprofessional Social Alex
 - Diet and Nutrition, Dentistry, Physiotherapy, Nursing, and Pharmacy
 - There will be a show case of what each faculty does and there will be an after party afterwards
 - Details are not fully set
 - Don't want to get money from each faculty so there might be ticket sales
 - Ticket sales based on number of students in each faculty Not sure if there will be a lot of interest if there are a lot of students from the same faculty
 - Tentative date: End of November
- 5. First Aid Kit Kevin
 - Students usually go to Students Services to get first aid supplies (ie. bandages) but they need to fill out a form every time even if it is something like a papercut
 - Should we store a first aid kit (ie. bandages) in the BCPhA Commons?
 - o Issues: will people just take the whole box?
