- 5. Sober Support Initiative Geoff
 - We coordinate PCP, First Dose, Pub Crawl, Post-Skits Night, Gala (drinking events associated with our faculty)
 - We should have some designate sober people who can perform damage control (calling for taxis, dealing with emergency situations, someone is throwing up in the bathroom, or someone is passed out)
 - Council general feelings:
 - these incidents are generally under control but we might want this as a reassurance to participants and faculty
 - Security guards, bar tenders, location staff are also trained to deal with these sorts of situations
 - This is a nice preventative thing to have just in case an incident does occur, it only takes one mishap at these events to make the faculty want to shut these events down
 - It's an interesting idea to explore, it's good to be proactive instead of reactive
- 6. Hockey team budget redistribution Hafeez
 - Hafeez is unsure of the procedure
 - Last 2 hockey teams, each team is reimbursed 400 dollars. But this year, the teams merged, so we're gonna give them \$625, 50% coverage
- 7. Position on volunteer pharmacy positions Margaret
 - A few pharmacies have been asking for volunteer positions from the faculty
 - Council agrees to allow the Communications Officer to reject these offers from pharmacies
 - We do not want to advertise volunteer positions internal to the student body, it is up to individual students' discretion on whether or not they would like to volunteer for pharmacies
 - We do endorse volunteer pharmacy work
