Discussions:

- 1. Referendum Alex
 - a. Alex will be Elections Officer and Simon Zhou will be Elections Committee
 - i. Must remain neutral regarding the referendum
 - **b.** Need to do a 10 minute presentation to each year
 - i. Need to clearly define what the processes are if the referendum passes or fails, ie. how people will be paying, how they will opt out
 - ii. When presenting the results, need to avoid any bias

- iii. Simon Qi will make the presentations
- **c.** Need to look into having a neutral third party to look over the presentations
 - i. Jerold Chu will take on this role
- 2. PIF Application [Jerold Chu] Simon Zhou
 - a. Inviting members from various professional organizations
 - **b.** Was planning to have it on March 29th but BCPHA is unable to attend so it might be moved to next term
 - **c.** Purpose is to ensure that all students know about the framework as it affects everyone and not many students were aware of it
 - **d.** Money will go towards: food, honorariums for presenters
 - e. GCs and Year Reps are in favour of this initiative
- 3. Sports Night Invalid Rosters Sam Chu
 - **a.** Registration was on the 13th
 - **b.** At least 3 teams had invalid rosters, though the situation was dealt with
 - i. All 3 teams had people who were playing on all 3 teams
 - **ii.** There was a loophole that you could have duplicate players on teams, but it's just a logical understanding that you can't compete against yourself
 - 1. It was generally due to miscommunication between players
 - iii. Giving them a period to readjust their rosters, though they can't add new players – afterwards will do a roster check and one team will get disqualified
 - iv. Teams on waitlist had proper rosters so it's unfair to them to allow invalid teams to find a new players
 - **c.** Fee collection period might be too long (2 weeks)
 - **d.** Next time the event is run, make it clear that everyone should be completely sure that the people are on their teams so there's no confusion
 - e. Teams on waitlist have asked for the event to be expanded
 - i. Could look into doing this in the future but at this point the schedule is already very tight
