- 1. <u>Updates regarding Shoppers Drug Mart Barbecue</u> Elisa
  - a. Overall reception for event was great: people enjoyed the food and atmosphere
    - i. Earned \$300 in revenue, went \$600 over budget
      - 1. Last year earned \$1500 in ticket sales alone
    - ii. Possibly due to 1<sup>st</sup> years redeeming all their food tickets but upper years not buying any tickets for food
  - b. Possible reasons for low attendance
    - i. Due to 4<sup>th</sup> years no longer on campus, there are less people to attend.
    - ii. CAPSI meeting happened concurrently to BBQ
  - c. Some Shoppers Drug Mart managers were confused at the start of the event and felt the start was not structured enough
    - i. Set up for BBQ was lacking personnel due to all years having class/IA right before
      - 1. In the future, make sure all PhUS execs are present to help set up for events
- 2. Updates regarding Gala Elisa
  - a. Gala will be held at the **Pinnacle hotel** instead of Sheraton on **Oct. 26**th
    - i. Ticket prices will be the same as last year (\$65/person) to ensure buffer for budget
  - b. There were some concerns regarding low attendance due to turnout from BBQ for the Gala
    - i. Event Page will be launched later this week
    - ii. Marketing Tactics:
      - 1. Word of mouth, stagger FB event sharing
      - 2. Stress to 3<sup>rd</sup> years this is their last Gala to increase incentive
