Discussions:

1. VP Internal

- a. MIF application by Jamie Park and Rachel Tandun (The End: A Hopeful Chapter of Life)
 - This MIF was approved by last year's council, but their program was affected by COVID. Under normal circumstances, MIF reapplications are not permitted but due COVID, we have decided to void this rule.
 - ii. Workshops and art displays originally discussed with the original application are no longer possible and will be moved to virtual alternatives (e.g Online artwork where participants can share thoughts and fears on end-of-life care)
 - iii. Project will begin in Fall 2020 (e.g September/October). Website to be launched in December. Project to be closed in Spring 2021 (e.g March/ April)
 - Funding to go towards maintenance, advertising, web developers İ۷.
 - 1. The remaining \$300 in expenses listed in the application will be out-of-pocket

2. VP Finance

- a. Possible options to secure additional funding for clubs who are financially struggling due to COVID-19
 - i. VP Finance, President, and VP Internal (Jessica, Parsa, and Jeremy) have noted that clubs may be struggling to find sponsors
 - 1. This can be offset clubs holding fewer events than in previous years
 - ii. Currently discussing the possibilities of:
 - 1. Emergency funding for clubs who have previously hosted and are perhaps planning large events that create revenue (e.g LKS Manufacturers' Night)
 - 2. Amending Clubs Fund application (e.g maximum amount, timeframe)
 - 3. Refunding a percentage of PhUS surplus to students versus utilizing surplus to help clubs in need of additional funding
 - Discussion to be tabled for next meeting after we determine our surplus iii.

3. Secretary

- a. Altitude Healthcare Mentoring at Queen's University
 - Received an email from Thomas Stambulic & Meagan Wiederman, site coordinators for Altitude Healthcare Mentoring at Queen's University
 - ii. Provides mentorship to undergraduate students interested in healthcare by matching them with students in professional healthcare programs across Canada
 - iii. Currently Queen's doesn't have a Pharmacy program so they're reaching out to us seeking potential students interested in being partnered up
 - We will ask site coordinators for registration info and then pass it on to OSS person once iv. they've been hired

4. Senator:

- a. Discussion regarding BPSc student fees
 - AMS not currently inducting new undergraduate societies i.
 - Need to determine where student fees are going so that we can spend the money for BPSc students' benefits

- iii. Concern: A portion of money collected by PhUS will go to UptoDate which the BPSc students may not find beneficial
 - 1. UptoDate currently only has enough capacity to allow all 4 years of PharmD students to gain access
 - 2. Will need to table this discussion and find a way to allow BPSc students to opt out from UptoDate
