1. VP Internal

a. Potential Changes to the Clubs Fund Document

- I. Allowing recurrent events as long as it benefits all students in all years (previously Clubs Fund was intended for individual events that were not recurrent)
- II. There will be no maximum percentage of funds for food costs in recurrent events
- III. Clarification for a cap of maximum 50% of the funding (\$250) being spent in one term

 A. No maximum on the number of applications applied per club
- IV. The Constitution Review Committee has decided that the current Clubs Fund already addresses clubs' concerns for needing funding for COVID-19 circumstances. We will focus on informing clubs that this is an available resource, rather than creating a separate fund.
- V. Discussion will remain tabled so that the Constitution Review Committee may further deliberate the option of a cumulative funding of \$500 to be spent over the course of both terms.
