Discussions:

1. VP Internal

a. PIF Application by John Lee and Tom Sun for their LEAP project

- i. Dr. Pearson tried to reach out to JP (OETLD) but because the recording equipment is in high demand within the faculty, John and Tom are unable to gain access to it
- ii. Will be amending the original application to only cover the cost of the microphones and thank-you gifts for the interviewees (\$310 total)
- iii. Microphones will be returned to PhUS after the LEAP project is over for student use

2. Sports Rep

a. Annual Ski/ Snowboard Trip

- i. Will need to consider which mountain based on transport, safety guidelines
 1. Currently leaning towards Grouse over Cypress due to convenience
- ii. How many people will go?
 1. 30 lift and day passes will be covered by PhUS. We will do a sign-up and then a draw for the spots, since it filled up very quickly last year. This ensures fairness.
 2. Google Form will only allow for 1 email per response to avoid multiple sign-ups

b. Using PhUS Instagram to promote fitness/ healthy eating

- i. Posts to include mental health and other health-related topics too
- ii. Will consider increasing engagement by doing +1 raffle entry for various events (e.g ski trip) if you follow PhUS on Instagram

3. VP Academic:

a. Year reps on hosting asynchronous lectures

- i. PY3 Year Rep will be doing a survey to gauge interest in all pharmacy years
 1. Would entail hosting a Zoom/ Discord call and streaming the lecture so that students can watch it together and feel more connected that way
- ii. PY2 Year Rep survey (110 participants):
 1. Majority of class (57%) wants to have assessment material cut-off date on Friday for assessments taking place on Wednesday
 2. 77% want EOB on Friday before Reading Week
- iii. Ways to engage Pharmacy Years and enforce the "Pharmily" spirit?
 1. PY1: Discord used for casual things like playing Among Us. Active chats include announcements/ notes
 2. PY2: will need to work on improving Discord engagement
