Discussions:

1. VP Academic - Re: Pipeline

a. Pipeline that weren't discussed

i. Changes to the ICE exam

1. Students are concerned about the new addition of Part 3 to the ICE exam, which consists of 4-5 written questions regarding the same cases of Part 1 and 2 (WICE and oral case respectively) but in a closed book setting
2. Students have traditionally done better in WICE than PICE, and are worried that the closed book format will negatively impact their quiz
3. From discussions on Pipeline and social media, students would like to know:
 - a. Why this change occurred
 - b. How it would affect students and their academic performance
 - c. What steps they should take to prepare for this change

ii. Dr. Wilbur responding to i.

1. ICE exams require a lot of time, effort, and logistics to execute, especially due to the constricted timeline of exam scheduling to make room for supplementals
2. The ICE exam is meant to mimic real life practice as much as possible
3. Faculty understands that passing is a high concern, especially in Term 2 when students need to pass to continue for practicum
4. This change (the addition of Part 3) was meant to take place in 2019-2020 Term 2 (April) but due to COVID, it has been deferred to 2020-2021 Term 1 (December)
5. We will be reaching out to Dr. Seto if possible, so that students have an opportunity to have their questions answered.

b. Changes to PHRM 221 (Nutrition for Pharmacists)

- i. Faculty is debating whether to change the number of credits
- ii. Dr. Wilbur will be sending out a Qualtrics survey soon to upper years who may have input on how faculty can better the course
