Discussions:

1. President

a. Re: New BPSc club

- i. The goal is to establish a club that gives the new BPSc students a means to connect and form their own group, without having to establish a separate entity (e.g new student society)
- ii. The new BPSc club will share and collaborate with PhUS in a “Venn Diagram” type format, where events that benefit both majors (e.g Manufacturers’ Night, Careers’ Night) will include both BPSc and PhUS students, while events that benefit Pharmacy students more (e.g Residency Night) will remain open to Pharmacy students only.
- iii. BPSc student AMS Student Society fees this year (2020-2021) were directed towards PhUS this year (\$66.15/student) which we will not be needing to return, but future student fees will have a majority portion directed towards BPSc to make them self-sufficient and fund their initiatives
- iv. Each faculty may only have one society under AMS so PhUS will continue to represent the Faculty of Pharmaceutical Sciences
- v. PhUS has voted to support the creation of BPSc Club in principle, and will be forwarding a letter to reflect this, so that the BPSc club can be fully established by September 2021.

2. VP Internal

- i. The Yearbook Club would like to hold a photo contest to engage the student body, similar to previous photo contests
- ii. Currently requesting \$60 for 3 x \$20 Amazon gift cards

3. VP Academic
