Discussions:

1. VP Internal

- a. Re: TCF Application by Lillian Cao
 - i. As previously discussed, the following application is to reimburse the ticket price for Together: Canada's Hospital Pharmacy Conference, a weeklong virtual conference regarding pharmacy leadership, clinical practice, and pharmacy management
 - ii. Currently requesting \$52.50 for the ticket price

2. VP Academic

- a. Delayed IA mini-assessment grades released
 - i. PY3s only have results from 2 of the 5 mini-assessment grades from IA
 - ii. Students require their grades before their last mini-assessment to see what the stakes are, and so that they can learn from past mistakes
 - iii. Students have been told that grades are hopefully going to be in by Friday but no guarantees have been made
 - iv. Faculty has stated that students who are at risk of failing IA are generally contacted midway through the term to discuss their standing and to make adjustments
 - v. Grades will be aimed for release prior to the last mini-assessment (MA) on March 30



Round Table:

Faculty	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Senate upheld motion to restrict use of Proctorio and Pharm is taking measures to comply by removing Proctorio for EOBs & ICE exams. Assessments that are taking place soon after the motion has passed (e.g PY1 DERM/MSK EOB) will continue to use Proctorio for the time being. - Faculty is currently trying to determine how to administer exams for Med Man and non-Med Man courses. They are currently debating between simulated live invigilation (e.g via Zoom) and/or open-book cases to be worked on - Adjusting for Proctorio will be more challenging for CFA students, who will require that a CFA invigilator be scheduled for monitoring. CFA invigilators will likely be more in demand given the removal of Proctorio in other faculties. - Course scheduling for Winter 2021-2022: Currently unsure if we will have all rooms at 100% availability and if students are comfortable with coming, but AMS requires room booking information by March 31. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Current plan is to have large courses in the main hall (PHRM 1101) “live streamed” so that students can interact with the prof while viewing lecture remotely - Hesitant to suddenly jump back into in-class lecture and currently debating a “mixed” format e.g 4 hours live in building and the rest asynchronously - BPSc students will be sharing the space with us but Pharm building is currently building a lecture hall for them - Students should have confirmation by the time they register for courses (July)
President	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - PhUS Exec elections are live until March 26, 2021 (Friday) at 11:59 PM - Parsa, Giordano, and Jessica are currently working on addressing wage parity in regards to Pharmacy students administering COVID vaccines with VCH <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students who are injections-certified (PY3, 4) are encouraged to apply.
