Description: "The Pharmily Mentorship Program is an initiative meant to guide incoming first year PharmD students into the program and ease their transition. We pair PY1 students with either a PY2 or PY3 student, who will provide social support throughout. Pharmacy is a very small profession and this is a great way for first years to network and connect with others who were in their shoes not too long ago."

- Purpose of the club: To give first year students a helping hand from the current student population and help strengthen the pharmacy student community
 - The club had positive evaluations and benefitted all of the students (Mentors and Mentees)
 - A total of 123 students participated in the first year of the club
 - Extensive matching was performed to ensure the mentors and mentees were compatible
 - The team will continue to use the evaluation forms to ensure that they can continue to help strengthen the pharmacy student community
