1. VP Internal

- a. Clubs Fund application by Pharmacy Vocale Ensemble Chris Xi and Lindy Pangka
 - Motion is approved.
 - Money will be used for purchasing new sheet music and binders with Pharmacy Vocal ii. Ensemble logo to hold sheet music during practices and performances.
 - Most likely will not be spending the full \$500. iii.
- b. Clubs Fund application by P-Talc Wesley Phan
 - DropBox was chosen because it keeps the stored information within Canada which is required by UBC.
 - 1. DropBox is not FIPPA compliant → consult John Paul Marchand to find the most appropriate storage app to use.
- c. Clubs Fund application by UBC Pharmacy Pediatrics Arooj Hayat
 - Hosted a successful Information Night session with 47 in-person and 7 online participants attending the session.
 - ii. Will submit the club's fund application 4 weeks in advance from now on.

2. VP Finance

- a. UptoDate usage + contract
 - 3 year contract (started 2019) \rightarrow Ending this year (2021)
 - 1. Promote UpToDate (Year Reps to help out)
 - 2. Determine the number of students who are currently using UpToDate
 - a. Post a survey on the Pharmacy Hub FB page to evaluate its benefit within the student body.
 - To be posted by October 4, 2021
 - 3. Current cost of contract \$27,000 (increases by \$2000 each year)
 - Plan when the contract ends (March 2022) ii.
 - 1. Initiate a referendum to determine if students want to pay an extra amount to compensate for uptodate contract fee.
 - 2. In 2019, the referendum was voted to increase PhUS fee by \$25 per student to pay UpToDate contract fee. This might increase if students decide to continue our

contract with UpToDate. (Current cost of Student subscription is roughly $^{\sim}219$ USD).

3. VP Social

- a. Proposal for Halloween Party in the Atrium (October 29, 2021)
 - i. Plan was discussed with John and confirmed with Jamal (Operations team).
 - ii. Plan:
 - 1. Host 300 people (50% of the maximum capacity due to COVID) → May need to change the capacity.
 - 2. Friend groups stay together, social distance, masks off when eating (mezzanine) otherwise masks **on** at all times.
 - 3. Discuss with Tony Seet (safety committee) to be aware of safety requirements, and submit a safety-plan.
 - 4. Event planning in progress: Movie, dinner, costume contest.
 - 5. Event location(s) Atrium, main lecture hall, and potentially mezzanine
 - 6. Save seats for BPSc students if there are seats available for them (PharmD students get priority).
 - iii. Consult with Dr. Wilbur regarding the event planning process.
