- c. Kruti S (Secretary/Co-founder - UBC Pharmacy Pediatrics Club):
  - i. UBC Pharmacy Pediatrics Club will be hosting a Lunch and Learn on ‘Communicating with Pediatrics Population and their parents/guardians as a healthcare provider.’





- ii. The event is set to take place on Friday, March 4, 2022 via zoom (link will be available at a later date). Arooj Hayat (PY3; co-founder of PPC) will be providing the talk. UBC PPC is requesting \$20 to buy a gift card for the speaker.
- iii. Questions/Comments from PhUS Council:
  1. Marcus W (VP Internal): I was not aware that the \$20 gift card was to be given to a student (Arooj H - PY3). Have we provided gift cards to student presenters previously?
    - a. Jeremy B (President): This has not been done in the past 2.5 years. Arooj is one of the co-founders for the club so it is a bit odd to provide a gift card to a club member for speaking on behalf of the club.
    - b. Maria A (Grad Rep 2023/Co-founder - UBC Pharmacy Pediatrics Club): It is more of our policy to give a gift card to the speaker as a thank you. But it's up to the PhUS council's discretion.
  2. Marcus W (VP Internal): I am not comfortable moving forward with this application at this time. Speaker fees are typically given to thank working professionals for taking time out of their busy schedules and have not been granted to student presenters in the past. Reimbursing students for speaking at club events that they are directly involved in planning does not seem appropriate.
    - a. As an example, I gave a talk on behalf of PhUS two weeks ago at the Pharmily Interclub Conference and it would have been odd to apply to receive an incentive as a student presenter. It would also be inappropriate for PhUS Council members to apply for incentives for speaking at PhUS AGM or for students presenting at PEAC journal clubs.
    - b. Clubs Fund applications where the 'thank you' gift cards are given to external speakers (who are not students directly associated with the club) are more the norm.
    - c. Jeremy B (President): If the UBC Pharmacy Pediatrics Club finds a new speaker who is a professional (not directly connected to the club) then would they be able to submit a CF application on that basis?
      - i. Marcus W (VP Internal): Yes, of course!
    - d. Lilyan J (VP Academic), Zyrel Z (PY3 Rep), Isabella W (PY2 Rep): We agree with Marcus' statement.
