- How to Read
 - Difference between two accounts (ie GPA) is the allocation/budget given to the event
 - o If doesn't have a "revenue" source, the amount in the expense is the budget (ie. UpToDate)

 - Student Fees 76.68 per PharmD and BPSC Student*
 - Ticket Sales
 - Sponsorship
