 - Opportunities for student engagement, leadership development, and experiences in industrial pharmacy and healthcare technology
 - Increase awareness for non-traditional pharmacy paths through guest speakers, lunch and learns, podcasts, etc
 - Networking with mentors in industrial, research and healthcare technology fields
 - o UBC PharmD students have the least representations in these fields compared to the pharmacy students in Eastern Canada

 - Currently the capacity of student pairing is unknown, however, those numbers will be more refined throughout the years
 - Have set up a good base of connections in Vancouver and will expand connections through Faculty members and current
- Current members will be overseeing the overall
 - Recruiting more executive members: Chair_Industry, Chair_Health Tech, Chair_Sponsorship, Chair_Finance and Treasurer, Chair_Marketting and Communications, Chair_Events, Secretory
 - Membership will be free
