a. New Club Application

- Applicants: Hana Rahili (PY2), Hasti Haghdadi (PY1), Ronak Amir Sardari (PY2), Romina Amir Sardari (PY3)
- Club name: Pharmaceutical Industry and Health Technology Club (PITEC)
- Opportunities for student engagement, leadership development, and experiences in industrial pharmacy and healthcare technology
- Increase awareness for non-traditional pharmacy paths through guest speakers, lunch and learns, podcasts, etc
- Networking with mentors in industrial, research and healthcare technology fields
 - UBC PharmD students have the least representations in these fields compared to the pharmacy students in Eastern Canada
- Aid students that are interested in industry to build a foundation to guide their career path
- Introduce non-clinical pharmacy paths
- Raise awareness involving opportunities in this stream
- resources required from PhUS: funding towards club events
- future initiatives:
 - Lunch and Learns
 - Monthly Workshop Series
 - Mentor/Shadowing opportunities





- Speed networking (will be creating online opportunities through connecting students through Zoom)
- Mentor connections: through LinkedIn
 - Current members of the club have connected with
 - Ex. Current Industry residents, start-ups, BC Life Sciences Director, UBC MedTech Club
 - Currently the capacity of student pairing is unknown, however, those numbers will be more refined throughout the years
 - Have set up a good base of connections in Vancouver and will expand connections through Faculty members and current
- Current members will be overseeing the overall
 - Recruiting more executive members: Chair_Industry, Chair_Health Tech, Chair_Sponsorship, Chair_Finance and Treasurer, Chair_Marketing and Communications, Chair_Events, Secretary
 - Membership will be free
- Dr. Wilbur's question:
 - Does the club want to consider a Faculty Liaison
- Ginette's question:
 - Connection with the BPhSc students? Yes, will be opened to all pharmacy students under the PhUS
- General concerns for pre-approval:
 - Will the club be able to accomplish all the events that are outlined in the application? There are already 18-19 clubs, and the PhUS lounge is currently running out of space
 - This club may have a lot of overlap with schedules of other club events
 - Next time the club presents at the PhUS meeting, the club should have all the event projections outlined clearly (with hard deadlines)
 - May ask the club to make a more detailed presentation moving forward (one year timeline)
- give the applicants 2 weeks to prepare a more detailed presentation
 - Ex. who are the mentors, how much time can they devote to the mentorship program etc

- b. PIC Clubs Fund Application
 - Alix Logan (PY3) requesting **\$200** to help fund The Wealthy Pharmacist Workshop on November 30, 2022
 - Breakdown:
 - 10 large pizzas x \$15.99/pizza = \$159.90 + tax
 - 3 x \$3.39/2L soda = \$10.17 + tax
 - New event and hoping to do one every semester- students can come in and it will be like a workshop (attendance is exponentially higher with food)
 - Expecting 20-40 students
 - *Approved*



c. Travel and Conference Fund Application

- Adam Bleik (PY3) requesting \$200 to attend PDW in Saskatchewan from January 4th-8th, 2023
- first place winner of the Student Literacy Competition (SLC) hosted by CAPSI which won him a seat to attend PDW (\$250 value)
- this conference includes seminars discussing women in leadership, advocating for patient care, pain management, and mental health
- conference also hosts a Health Fair to allow for networking opportunities
- personal and professional development
- breakdown:
 - \$150 registration fee + hotel living costs for students attending the conference
 - approximately \$600 round trip flight
 - requesting \$200
