 - a. Produces ~\$1,201.04 per year (based on market)

 - 1. Canva Pro for Teams up to 5 individual accounts for \$199.90 per year
 - 2. Currently pay \$149.99 per year for one account (Personal Pro Account)
 - 3. Currently funded by VP Communications' personal budget
