2. Sponsorship Coordinator

New Guideline for the Hub - My Personal take (THESE NUMBERS ARE EXAMPLES)

Options	Example System	Pros	Cons
(Free student positions) - Most similar to Old Hub	Student Jobs = Free PY4 recruitment = PY4 reps (same as before) Alumni Jobs= Flat fee of 100\$ Advertisement (non jobs) = \$150	We get to keep student opportunities as available as before (Pharmacy Intern/Student/Injection positions) Jobs not for students PY1-4 (including recruitment posts - those will be on PY4 page) not taking attention away from Paid Sponsored posts/Advertisement	This info needs to be relayed down to each PhUS/Club Execs and PY4 reps EVERY YEAR to avoid build up on inconsistencies or unfair charges System only holds for as long as this info is passed down to ALL who may charge for posts

- Feedback from students → charging for job postings or opportunities may lead to a decrease in overall student opportunities
- Our PRIMARY GOAL is to make a system that sets a firm guideline that upholds fairness without creating confusion or ambiguity, NOT to collect money
- In order for this system to be successful:
 - All posts will be approval based → this helps us filter any posts that are not targeting current students and helps us direct them to the appropriate execs (VP Comms, Sponsorship Coordinator, PY4 rep, etc)
 - It must be CLEAR which posts are subject to fees and which are not
 - Posts NOT subject to fees:
 - Job postings directed to CURRENT STUDENTS (injection shifts, tech shifts, intern shifts, student positions, student research positions, etc)
 - Club posts, ANY posts (that are not advertising on behalf of a company) from ANYONE (alumni, business reps, faculty, students, etc)
 - Provincial or government initiatives
 - Posts Subject to fees:
 - PY4 recruitment → These are to be directed to the PY4 reps. PY4 recruitment posts should only appear on the PY4 page, due to its own posting policies and sponsorship packages as in previous years.
 - Advertising for mass recruitment (ie. Webinar session for mass interviews, info session on a pharmacy/business or insurance plans, etc)
 - Advertising for jobs that are for ALUMNI or fully licensed Pharmacists (ie. manager positions, pharmacist jobs in general)
 - Advertising for products, opportunities, events, etc that are NOT job opportunities for students
 - All post approvals should be under the jurisdiction of ONE committee to avoid confusion (either Sponsorship Committee or create another committee

3. Mentorship Coordinator
